

### Ice Cream in a Bag Ingredients

- One gallon-sized bag
- One quart/sandwich-sized bag
- ½ cup rock salt
- ½ cup heavy whipping cream
- 1 tbsp sugar
- Flavor

### **Directions**

Place the cream, sugar, and any flavoring into the smaller bag and seal tightly and be sure there are no leaks. Fill the large bag with a third of ice and pour in the salt. ### **Swimming Pool Safety**

- Appoint an adult who can swim to watch children while they
  are in the pool. The supervising adult should not read, talk
  on the phone, leave or turn their back on the pool area, or
  do any other distracting activity while watching the children.
- Personal flotation devices do not replace adult supervision.
- Keep ladders, patio furniture, and toys away from aboveground pools.
- Keep pool water clear and remove floats and toys when the pool is not in use.
- Learn CPR and keep rescue equipment, a telephone, and emergency numbers near all pools.
