

FIZZY RAINBOW MATERIALS LIST: Shallow trays, Medicine

droppers or Eyedroppers, Baking Soda, White vinegar, Food Coloring

Provide bowls of vinegar and food coloring. The students can use little medicine droppers to



drip the vinegar onto the baking soda tray. Listen to the chemical reaction of the vinegar and baking soda. Watch what happens when the colors start to mix. This simple activity will keep your students engaged!

# RAINBOW FISH FOIL PAINTING

### Art

### **Materials Needed:**

Aluminum Foil Paint Q-Tips Paint Brushes Scissors

#### Directions:

To begin you'll want to trace your fish shape out onto your aluminum foil and then cut it out. Next, children can start painting using a variety of bright colors. Finally, BEFORE the paint dries, have children take some Q-tips and use them to draw designs onto the fish so that the shiny foil shines through. You'll need a few Q-tips for this step because once the tips are covered in too much paint they don't wipe the paint off as well.

### COVID - 19 Info

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) is now reporting 85 teens and adult staff at a summer youth camp held in mid-June in central Illinois tested positive for COVID-19. One unvaccinated, young adult was hospitalized. Although all campers and staff were eligible for vaccination, IDPH is aware of only a handful of campers and staff receiving the vaccine. The camp was not checking vaccination status and masking was not required while indoors. **IDPH is reminding people about the importance of vaccination**, including youth, as the Delta variant and other variants continue to spread.
