

MITTEN SNOWBALL GAME



To get ready for this game, simply cut a mitten shape out of each color of felt. Cut a circle out of white felt for the snowball. Hide the snowball under a mitten while your child closes his or her eyes.

Next, have your child try to guess where the snowball is hidden. "Is it under the green mitten?" Lift up the mitten and answer yes or no. Continue this with the other mittens until the snowball is discovered.

HEALTH & SAFETY

The quality of the air we breathe affects the health and wellbeing of children, staff, and families. Young children are sensitive to poor air quality, especially children with respiratory illnesses or chronic health conditions such as asthma. Poor indoor air quality can affect children's breathing, learning, and development. Viral particles that make you sick spread between people more easily indoors than outdoors. Improving ventilation and filtration can help protect people from getting infected with viruses and spreading them.
