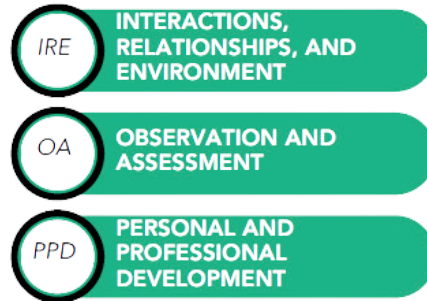

Social-Emotional Growth & Socialization Program for Infant Toddler Care Module 1

Social-Emotional Growth and Socialization explores topics on social-emotional development in the first three years, temperaments of children and caregivers, socialization, guidance and discipline, environments, and gaining an understanding of children's behavior. Training will begin with an overview of the basic concepts of early social-emotional growth and socialization and their application to the group care context. An emphasis is placed on the development of a nurturing relationship between the infant and caregiver. The overview addresses the importance of responsive caregiving, the individualization of care through an understanding of infant temperament, the critical role of family and culture in early identity development, exploring developmentally appropriate play strategies with ages of infancy, creating supportive physical environments and stages of emotional development.

Grant Opportunities for Child Care Programs

CPR & First Aid Reimbursements

Funds to assist child care practitioners in achieving First Aid/CPR certification. These funds cover costs associated with Pediatric FA/CPR including registration fees, student workbooks, and certification cards. The curriculum must be from an approved entity, as outlined in the reimbursement application. Additionally, the program must meet the qualifications as outlined in the application.

Individual Professional Development Funds

Funds can assist in covering costs related to earning credentials (such as the CDA exam) registration, travel, and lodging fees associated with conferences or workshops not required by ExceleRate™ Illinois. Funds are available for individuals, directors, owners, and administrators. A maximum of \$500 can be allocated to an individual per fiscal year (July - June).

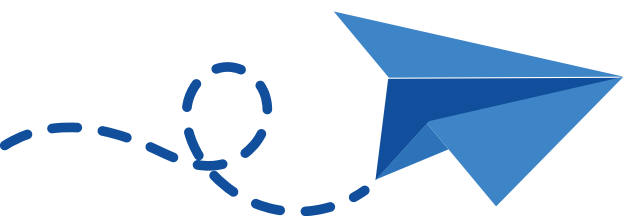

Early Departures: To receive a training certificate, participants must stay until the training is finished. If a participant leaves early, no hours or training certificate will be awarded.

Training Participation: Participants must actively engage in training to receive a certificate and training hours. Engaged is defined as participating in polls, using the chat box, sharing, and exchanging ideas, etc. Cameras must be on during most portions of virtual training. To ensure participants are safe and able to engage fully during the designated training time we ask that you refrain from activities that take away from your participation. Activities such as attending another training, shopping, attending sporting events, or being counted in your program's ratio. It is illegal to attend a Zoom session while operating a motor vehicle.
